GENERAL REMARKS

The boys in all classes make a very favourable impression. They are friendly, cooperative and, with few exceptions, industrious and interested in their work. Their quality of answering and discussing questions in the Religious Education period were especially commendable. The boys clearly hold the Brothers in high regard and are appreciative of their efforts and those of the lay-teachers.

The public examination results are of good standard. In the second successive year two Exhibitions were won, one General and one Subject Exhibition. The senior school has excellent science laboratories. However, an additional classroom for this area is needed especially in view of a likely senior enrolment exceeding one hundred pupils next year. In general Science at middle school level there is need for provision for laboratory work with split classes. Library facilities for the middle and Senior Schools are dependent upon an adjusted enrolment of 300 pupils, a figure which should be reached soon.
